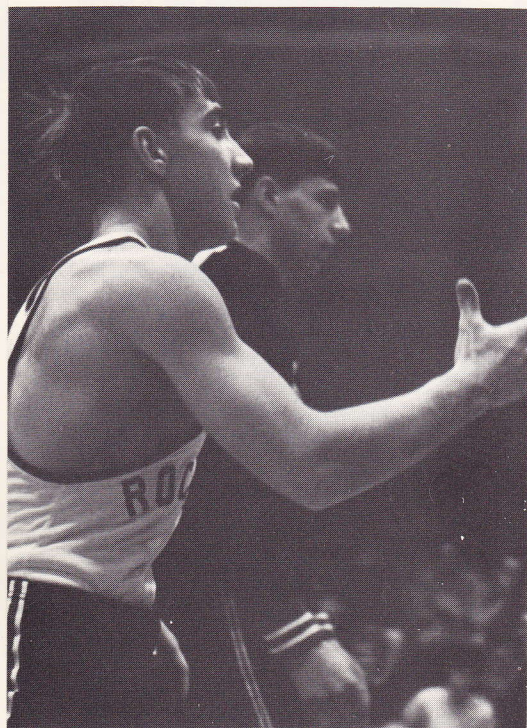

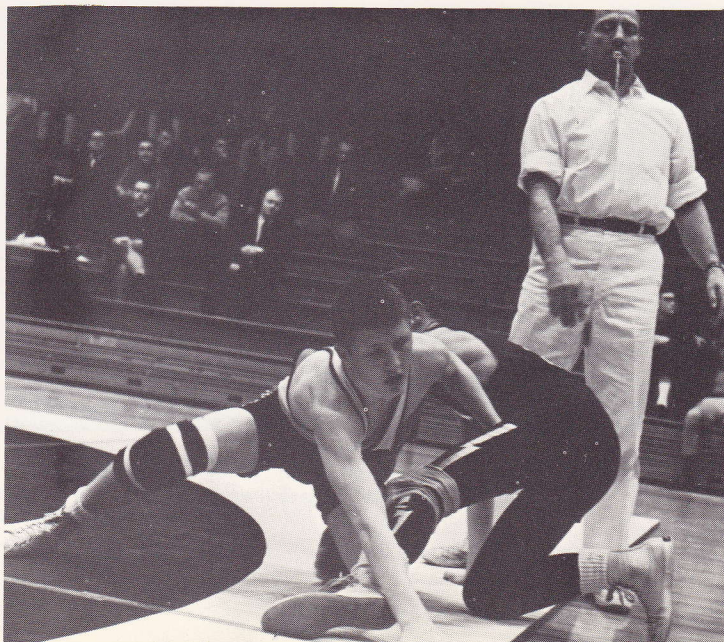

"Go get 'em"

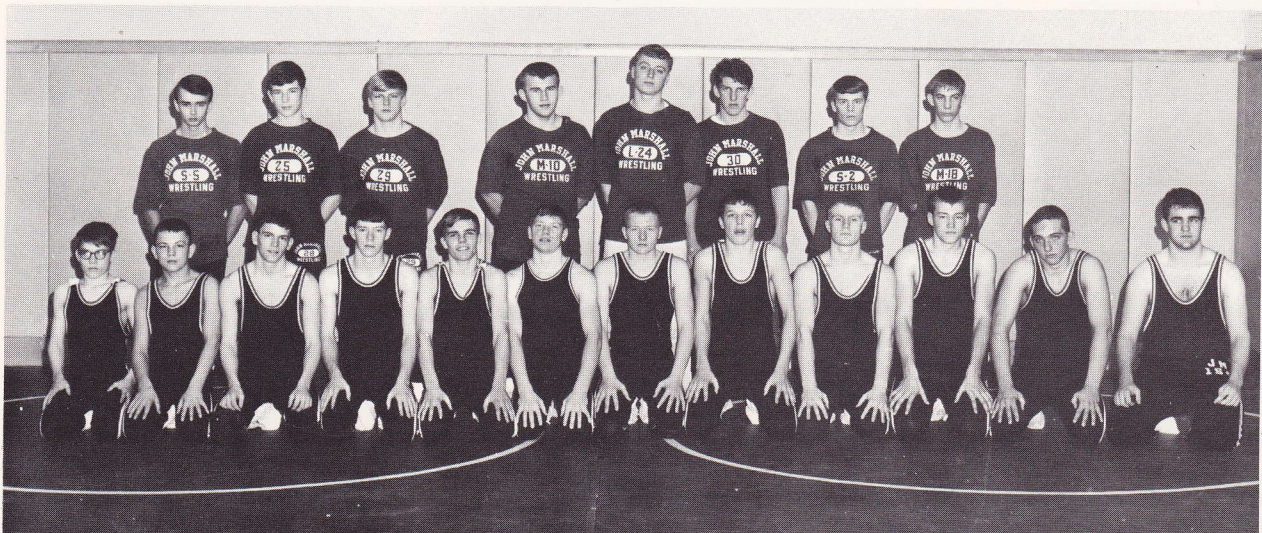
