


Above: Rocket grappler tries for pin as referee watches closely.

Right: Junior Al Atherton manuvers for the takedown.






The top scorers on this year's squad were Dave Campion, Chuck Caverly, and Terry Muller. Muller, Caverly, and Campion, were also District 3 champions.


Coach Ron White's team effort produced the best record a JM wrestling team has had in a decade. They captured 2nd place in the conference and ended with a 7-1 conference record.


The B-squad, coached by Gust Barbas had a strong 8-3 overall record and 6-2 conference record. The biggest win of the year was over Winona, 52-12.


This year's team was led by Steve Burt, Tim Gove, and Jack Drews. Next year's season looks good because of the numerous underclassmen coming up.
