





A wrestler flips his opponent to the mat.


Jon Schmitt(11) shows off a few of his fancy moves.

Traditionally mediocre, Rocket wrestling took steps this season toward a position as one of the Big Nine's title contenders.

Coached by Mr. Dan Hayes, Mr. Mark Kuisle and Mr. Pat Dunagan, the Rockets varsity team beat Lourdes and Mayo in dual meets. The team also finished third in the eight-team Burnsville Invitational Tournament. The Burnsville tournament was certainly a high point of the season for Will Schroeder(10), Dan Larsen(10), Paul Oelfke(12), and Joe Miller(12), who each won in his respective weight class. Joe was voted the tournament's Outstanding Wrestler.


Junior Varsity proved that the Rockets are indeed building some firepower.
